→ Write a list of animals that live in Africa. Can you write a sentence about which African animal is your favourite? My favourite animal is.../I like....

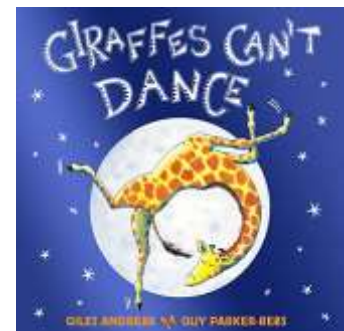
(Challenge: use the word 'because' in your writing and remember to use a full stop at the end of a sentence)
