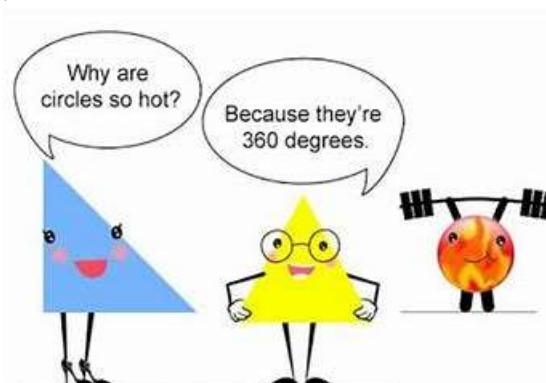
I think crocodiles are truly awesome animals. What is your favourite animal and why?
