can teach lots of new things when I see you again.*

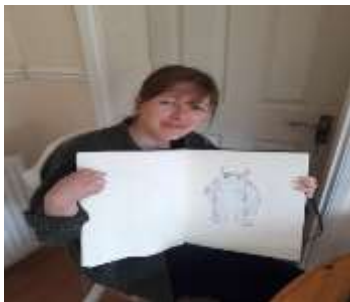
My eldest daughter is having a birthday this weekend so we have been
