- Develop medium and long term plans which appeal to all groups to ensure correct, exciting curriculum coverage and links to the wider community
- Through an exciting mastery curriculum develop pupils who love the challenge of learning and are resilient to failure. Pupils to be curious and interested learners who seek out and use new information to develop, consolidate and deepen their knowledge, understanding and skills
- To ensure that each curriculum area has a clear statement of intent and implementation and that impact can be clearly demonstrated
