

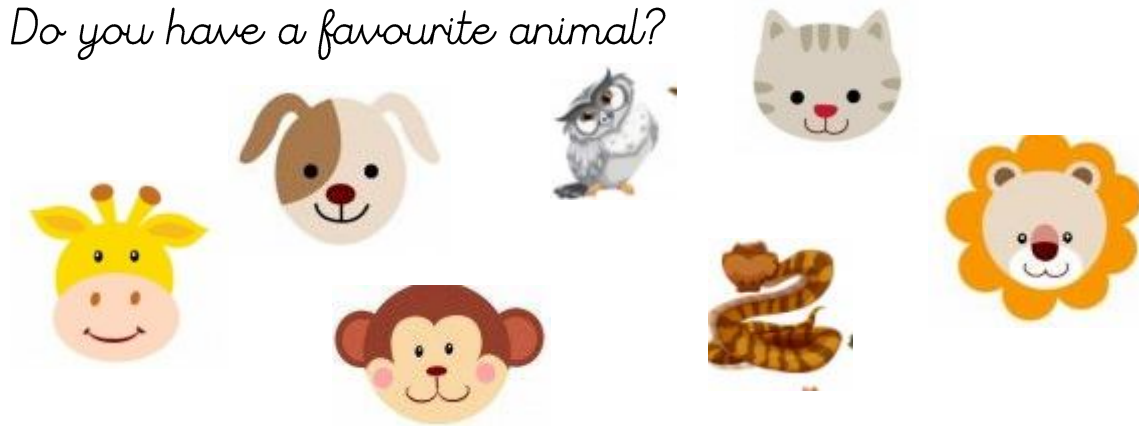
Week 5 Science.
