


## FIRST MAN ON THE MOON



The Astronauts flew to the Moon in a spacecraft called Apollo 11.



A small lunar module called The Eagle landed on the Moon with two astronauts inside. It took three days to get to the Moon.





It is 240,000 miles from Earth.

Neil Armstrong, aged 38, was the first man to walk on the Moon. He said, "That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind."



The landing was watched on television by 600 million people around the world. Apollo 11 is now on its way back to Earth and should arrive on the 24<sup>th</sup> July.
