Day 1 - Monday

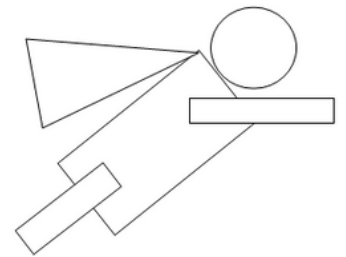
Literacy

What is a hero? A person who is courageous and brave, who helps us etc. With a grown up, talk about people in your life you may think are heroes, or people in our society who are heroes (e.g. doctors, nurses, etc) Who helps us?

Write a sentence about someone who helps you and draw a picture. (E.g. A nurse helps make us better.)

Maths

Can you draw a superhero or a super city using different 2-D shapes? Tell a grown up the name of each shape.



Communication and Language - Can you make up your own super hero story and tell an adult or sibling?

Literacy

Listen to the story 'Supertato'. Can you think of own vegetable/fruit to turn into a super hero? Draw a picture of your super vegetable/fruit and label it.

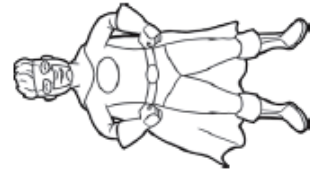
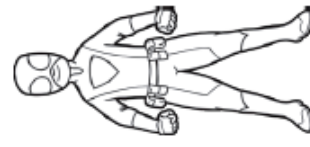
Maths

Personal, Social and Emotional - Superheroes keep trying and never give up, even when they find things tricky. Can you think of something you find tricky and keep practising it? Make sure you don't give up! (E.g. doing up your coat, tying a shoelace, patting your head and rubbing your tummy at the same time!)

Understanding the World - Can you work with a grown up and see if you can take a picture using a phone/ipad/camera of you jumping mid-air to look like you are flying like a superhero?

Day 3 - Wednesday

Literacy

Can you write a list of 5 - 10 things you need to be a great superhero? (E.g., fast, kind)

Maths

Can you make a repeating pattern on your superhero mask or cape?

Create it!

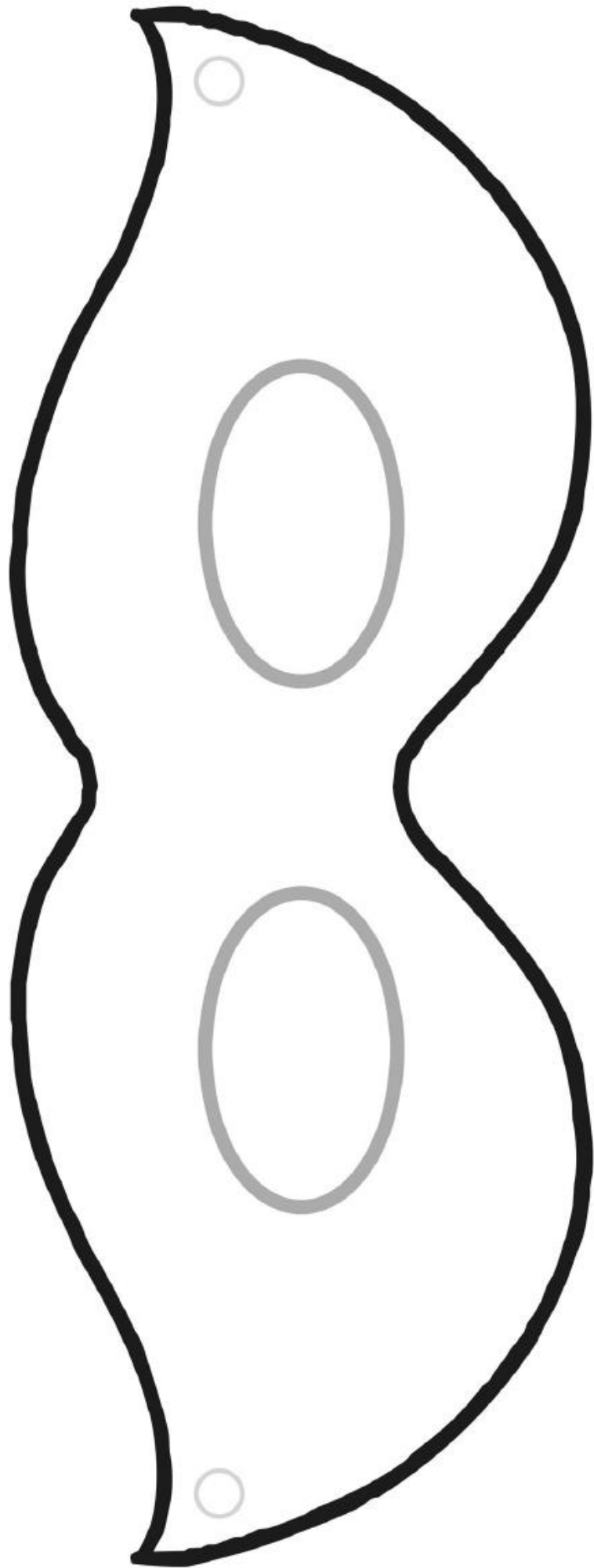


Challenge:

## Day 4 - Thursday

### Literacy

Listen to the story 'Superkid'. Talk about the different things Superkid did with his super powers. Can we think of any other super powers different superheroes have? If you could have a super power what would it be? Write a sentence and draw a picture of you as a super hero. (E.g. If I was a superhero I would be invisible!)

### Maths

Sharing - what is sharing? When we are playing with our friends and toys, would we keep all of them for yourself, and leave your friend with none? NO! We would share them. You could say as you are sharing 'one for me, one for you'

Using the toys in your home, can you share them with a grown up so you both have the same? A grown up can video you and show us on Tapestry!

Personal, Social and Emotional - Superkid encourages children to be super kind to each other. How can you be kind to other people? Friends, parents, siblings, teachers, grandparents etc.

Physical Development - Can you draw some pictures of superheroes and carefully colour them in and cut them out?

## Day 5 - Friday

### Literacy

Can you think of a pet Superkid could have? What could the pet be? A dog, cat, dinosaur, flamingo etc. What super power would the pet have? What would its name be? E.g. Superdog? Amazing dog?

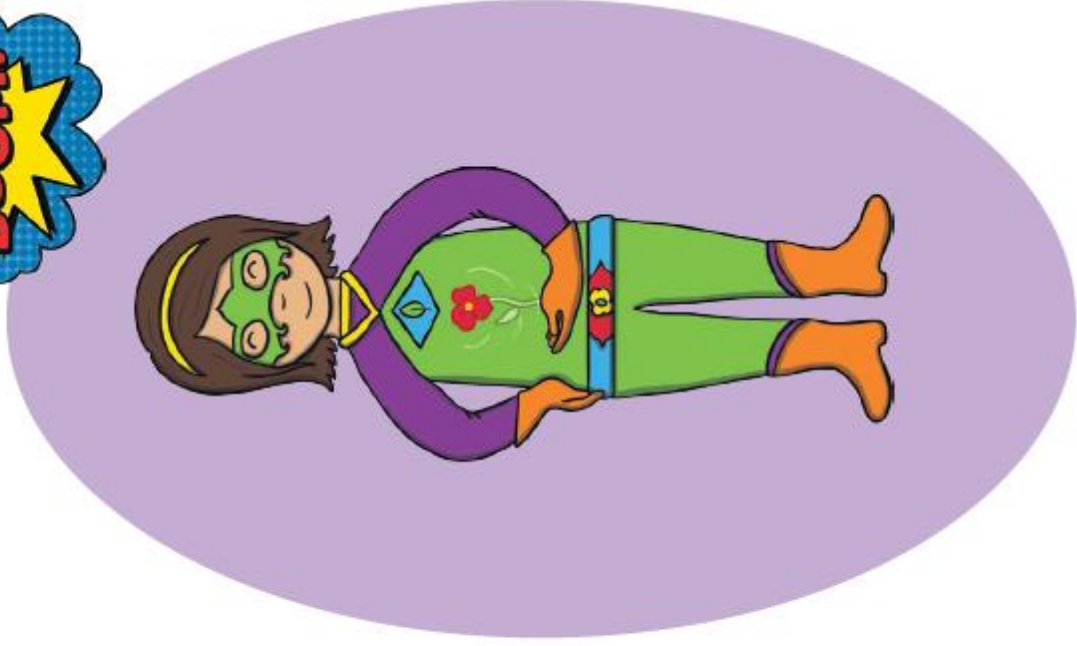
Draw a picture of Superkid's pet and write its name. (Superkid has a pet called ...)

### Maths

Can you remember what sharing is? 'One for me, one for you.'

Carefully cut out the masks and share them between 2 or 3 superheroes.

# Superhero Sharing







Understanding the World - Some superheroes have freezing powers! Talk about how to freeze things they must be very cold. Can you put some water in an ice cube tray and talk about where you could put them that is very cold. What might happen when you put it in the freezer? Once frozen, play with the ice cubes and see what happens!

Communication and Language - Ask a grown up to hide one of your toys in your home. Can you use your super listening powers to follow directions and find your toy?
