

Day 1 - Science

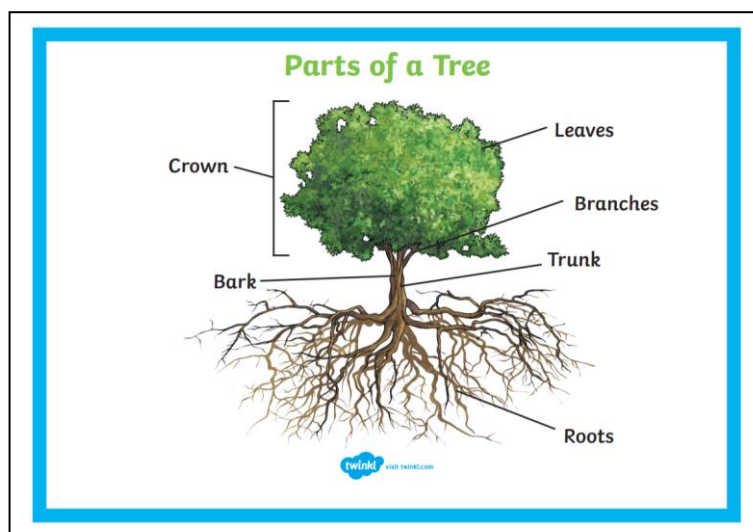
Here is a diagram of a tree. All the different parts have been labelled.

The leaves turn energy into food for the tree.

The roots absorb water from the soil and help to support the tree.

The trunk supports the tree and transports water to the leaves.

The branches help to transport water to the leaves.



Can you draw and label the different parts of a flower?

Use these words to label your pictures: flower, roots, stem, leaves, petals

Challenge

Write some sentences about the function of each part of the plant.
(What does each part do?)

E.g. The stem transports water around the plant and holds the plant upright.
