

Week 5. Monday, Phonics.

Today we will have another look at the sound 'ou'.



There are lots of words that use this sound. Can you remember any?

I can remember the words,

about, sound, sprout, mountain, plough, loud, cloud, out.

I have coloured the digraph 'ou' in red. Can you point to the 'ou' sound in the other words?

Let's practice our writing. Can you write the digraph 'ou'?

Now try and practice writing some words that use the 'ou' sound, they are above or you can use your own.

Can you write a sentence? Here is mine.

The snow plough was loud.

I can make that a WOW sentence.

The red snow plough was so loud it sounded like a big jet plane.

How did I make my sentence a WOW sentence? That's right, I expanded it and I also added two adjectives.

Can you see the adjectives? Remember, they describe something so they tell you more information. Red and big are the adjectives well done! Don't forget to use adjectives in your writing in English!

### Activity

Can you say a sentence out loud using each of the following words?

mountain, sprout, ground, house, mouse.

My sentence would be,

The mountain was big and covered in snow.

If you can, write your sentences down.
