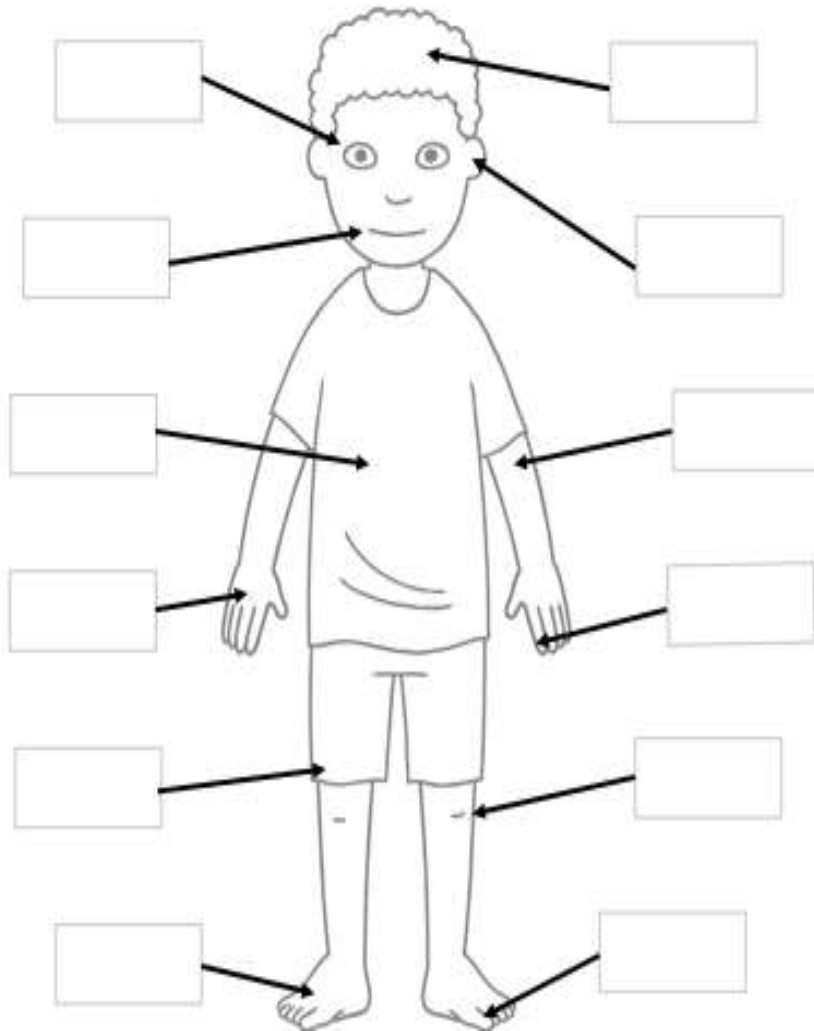
Have a chat with your grown up.
