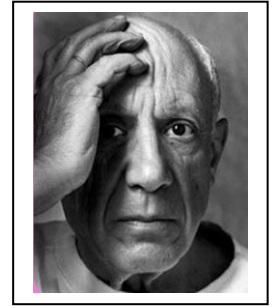


Year 1 Week 5 Art

In Art, we have been learning about self-portraits. This week we are going to do an abstract portrait in the style of Picasso.

Picasso was a Spanish artist who is considered to be the inventor of Cubism.



In Cubist artwork, an artist looks at an object and breaks it up, and represents it in an abstract form. Cubist paintings are not realistic, and are made up of lots of shapes. Here are some of Picasso's painting.



This week, we would like you to make a collage portrait using pictures from newspapers or magazines.

Find pictures of different faces and cut out some of the features (eyes, ears, mouth, nose).

Stick them on your paper to make a face.

You can put the features anywhere you like - it's best if they don't go in the right place!

Use other shapes and materials to make your portrait bright, colourful, and interesting!
