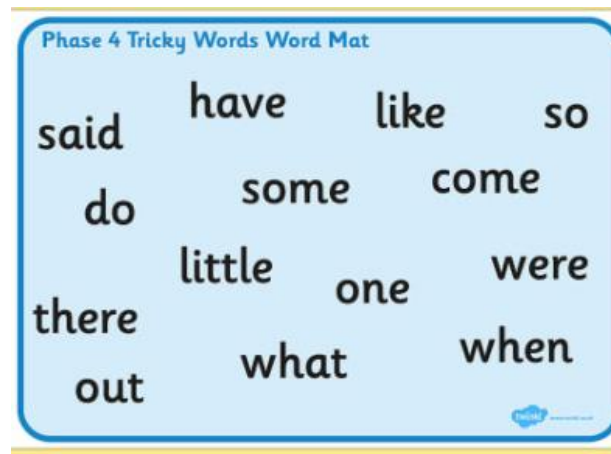


Spring 2 Week 1 - Friday Phonics.

Today we are going to continue with our Tricky Word recognition.

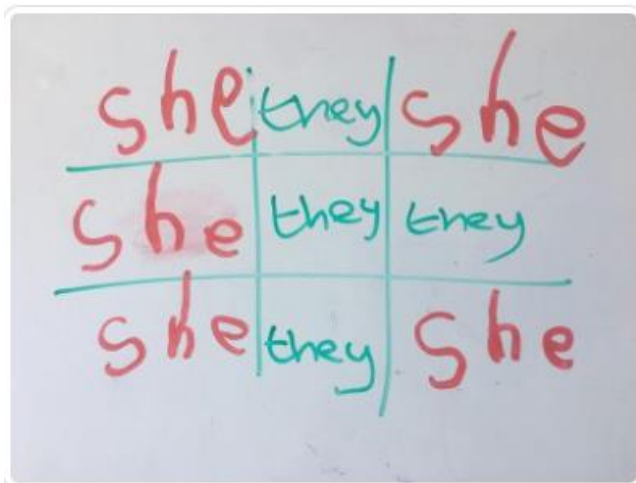


I know you have been working really hard learning your Tricky words over the past weeks, so today I am going to give you some ideas for games you can play at home to help you practice them.

Noughts and Crosses



Instead of using an X or O use a tricky word instead.

Make it Multi-Sensory



Write your tricky words in flour, salt, sand or even mud!

Play Teacher



Write the words on a piece of paper, whiteboard or chalkboard if you have one. Then test your family on the words. Did they get them right?

Make Some Noise!!!



Label some pots and pan using sticky notes with the tricky words on. Then someone asks you to find the word and you 'hit' it with a wooden spoon. The quicker you play, the more tuneful you could be. Remember to say the word as you 'hit' it.
