Our sound today is 'ea/e_e/ey'.



Can you remember this sound 'ee'?

Today's graphemes all sound the same as 'ee' but are written differently?

Many words use these sounds. Let us look at some:

sheep, seat, Pete, key.

All these words have the 'ee' phoneme in them, but are written in an alternative way. You will also see the 'ee' sound written as 'y' as in baby or 'e' as in me.

I know it is tricky to understand so watch the following videos to help you:

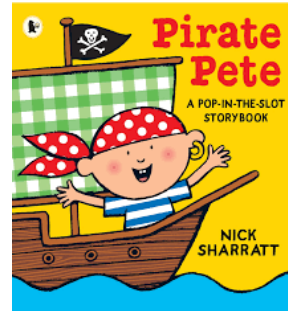
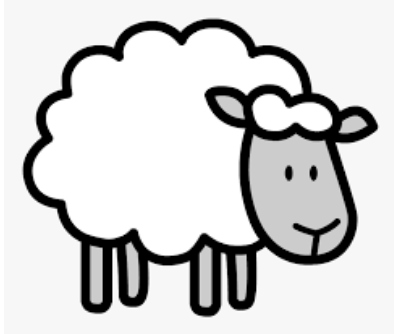
