'Don't worry, be happy' is a very famous a cappella song sung by Bobby McFerrin in 1988. A cappella means that only voices are used and no instruments. In this song, only Bobby McFerrin's voice was used - he imitates all the instruments vocally. This song is thought to comfort people when they are worried or sad.
