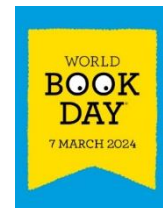

World Book Day is back again to change lives through a love of books and shared reading, and to give every child the opportunity to have a book of their own.

This year, it is on **Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March** and we will be celebrating it in lots of different ways. Firstly, we would like to continue our tradition of asking the children to come to school in their **pyjamas or onesies** and bring with them their favourite bedtime story to share. During the day, the children will watch 'The masked readers' and will try to identify which teachers are reading the stories.

We will be continuing our **book door quiz**; children in school will be decorating their class door to look like the front cover of a well-known book. Each class will walk around the school to view the doors and try to guess the author of each book. The class with the most correct answers will win books for their class.

We will be sending out the **£1 book vouchers**. You will be able to use your token to buy a new World Book Day book OR you can get £1 off selected books, including those at our **book fair** which will be held straight after school on the following dates: Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> February, Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> February in the KS2 Hall and Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March in the KS1 Hall. During 'World Book Week', we will monitor the usage of 'Bug Club' for each class and give out some **book prizes** for the classes who use it the most. If you do not know your child's login details for bug club, please speak to your child's class teacher.
